#### **DIRECTIONS TO HOSTOS COMMUNITY COLLEGE**

- The Longwood Art Gallery @ Hostos is located at Hostos Community College, 450 Grand Concourse and 149th Street, at a busy intersection just steps from the subway station and bus stop. By subway, take the #2, 4 or 5 IRT trains to 149th Street and the Grand Concourse. By bus, take the BX1 or BX19 to 149th Street and the Grand Concourse. Travel time from mid-town Manhattan is usually 20 minutes.
- By car from Manhattan, take the FDR drive north to the Willis Avenue Bridge to the Major Deegan Expressway (87N). Proceed north to Exit 3.
   Take the right fork in the exit ramp to the Grand Concourse and proceed north to East 149th Street.
- From Queens, take the Tri-borough Bridge to the Major Deegan Expressway. Continue north to Exit 3. Take the right fork in the exit ramp to the Grand Concourse and proceed north to East 149th Street.
